Alvah C. Ayers, 97 of Scituate, Rhode Island, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, May 24, 2022 just two weeks shy of his 98th birthday.

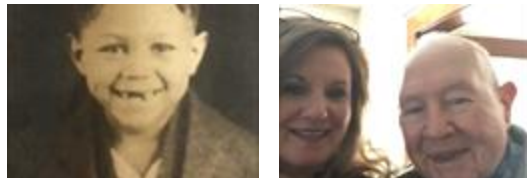
