Barbara Joan (Piche) McIntyre, 77, of Pawtucket, passed away on August 3, 2024.

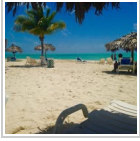
She was the wife of the late Peter V. McIntyre. Born in Providence, she was a daughter of the late Albert and Edith (Mills) Piche.
