Brenton Walter Morgenstern (80) peacefully transitioned on March 12, 2019 surrounded by his loving family.

Brent was born on June 13, 1938 in Providence, RI. Raised in North Providence, after graduating high school, he served in the United States Army during the Korean conflict. He was a Master Electrician for the IBEW Local Union 99 for 40 years, before retiring in 2001. He was proud of his work ethic and dedicated to his trade; traveling throughout New England on various projects during the years.

He was the son of Helmut and Hildegard Morgenstern. He is survived by his children, Brenton David Morgenstern (son) and Christine Marie Morgenstern-Shin (daughter); his son-in law, Karl Shin and his former wife, Mrs. Shirley Colucci Horgan. He leaves behind two grandsons, Brenton William Morgenstern and Ian David Morgenstern.

A decorated Eagle Scout, Brent was an avid outdoor enthusiast that enjoyed hunting, fishing and nature in its untouched state. He travelled extensively throughout North and South America, including Alaska, Brazil and Chile. Additionally, he made expeditions to South Africa, Canada (Northwest Territories, Saskatchewan and New Brunswick) and the Arctic Circle. Brent held numerous big game hunting records from the Boone and Crockett Club.

His passion of travel and nature led him to remote places; however, upon return he enjoyed sharing these adventures with his friends.
