Daniel Michael Barber, 80, passed away peacefully at home December 16, 2025 with his loving husband by his side.

Dan Barber was born on January 28, 1945, in Norwalk, Ohio, to the late Betty (Heffley) Barber and Floyd Robert Barber. In 1956, Dan moved to Warren, Rhode Island, where he was raised and later graduated from Warren High School.

Dan built a long and successful career in banking and finance. He began his professional life at Peoples Bank, where through dedication and hard work, he rose through the ranks to achieve the position of Vice President. In the 1980s, Dan worked for Collier Wire in Central Falls. He later joined AFC Cable in New Bedford, Massachusetts, serving as Credit Manager until his retirement in 2002 due to declining health.

Never one to slow down completely, Dan went on to become a part owner of the Providence nightclub The Stable, formerly known as Wheels, a place that held special meaning in his life.

Dan is survived by his loving spouse, Mark Ellinwood, whom he met at Wheels on Gay Pride Day in June of 1996. The two were married on June 25, 2016 and made their home together in Cranston, Rhode Island. They shared

a deep love for travel and explored the world together until Dan's illness made travel no longer possible.

Dan was predeceased by his sisters Nancy Minarsky (Barber) of Connecticut, Janice Barber of Pawtucket and Barbara Barber of Providence. He is survived by his brother Robert Barber and his wife Vallerie (Rocchio) Barber of Cranston, Rhode Island and his beloved half-sister, Missy Legan of Catawba Island, Ohio, the youngest of his siblings, with whom he reconnected and formed a meaningful bond beginning in 2015.

In 2018, Dan was diagnosed with Alzheimer's disease. In April of 2025, he received a cancer diagnosis and subsequently entered the compassionate care of Hospice of Care New England.

Dan will be remembered for his intelligence, strong work ethic, adventurous spirit and the deep love he shared with family and friends. His memory will live on in the hearts of all who knew and loved him.
