David is survived by his daughters, Sherry Skinner and Deborah Ann O'Donnell. He also leaves his dear friend of over twenty years, Theresa Choquette.

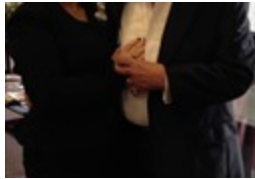
