Eugene Andre Lefebvre, lovingly known as “Geno,” passed away on May 2, 2026, at the age of 68. A resident of Glocester, Rhode Island, Geno was born on December 22, 1957, in Pawtucket, Rhode Island, to Marguerite (Fregeau) Doti and Lucien Lefebvre.
