John Albert Marsocci, affectionately known as “Johnny” by his mother, 60, passed away peacefully surrounded by his family on December 11, 2025 after a strong battle against cancer. In sum, John lived a beautiful life. John was born on March 31, 1965 in Providence, RI to loving parents Michael and Rose Marsocci. He moved to Johnston, RI before the age of two and was raised there with his siblings, graduating from Johnston High School in 1984.

John was a devout Catholic for much of his life and a member of Our Lady of Grace Church in Johnston, RI. Later on, he received a new life in Christ and became a member of the Trinity Assembly of God Church in Johnston, RI.

John was a kind, compassionate, loving, and truly genuine person who was always ready to help family, friends, and strangers.
