Kathleen H. Crowley, 72, of North Scituate, RI, passed away on March 18, 2023.

Kathleen worked as a registered nurse for 37 years, the majority for the Veterans Health Administration - US Department of Veterans' Affairs. She held various staff and management positions at the Providence VAMC and New England Veterans Integrated Service Network, including staff and ICU Nurse Manager and Associate Chief for Education. She was an adjunct faculty member at University of Rhode Island and Rhode Island College School of Nursing and a member of Sigma Theta Tau Nursing Honor Society. At the time of her retirement Kathleen held the position of Director of Telehealth Services for VA New England Healthcare System. She received various certificate awards, most notably she was the recipient of the 2000 Federal Employee of the Year Award in the Professional category and 1986 Military Order of the Purple Heart Professional Contribution Award.

Kathleen is survived by her niece Kendra Ann Crowley, her children Jack and Annie, and many other family and friends.

Kathleen is preceded in death by her parents John M. Crowley and Helen M. Crowley, and sister Ann Marie Crowley.
