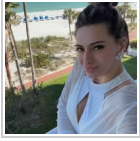
Lyndsey Elizabeth Reynolds (Macera), 35, passed away unexpectedly on December 20, 2023.

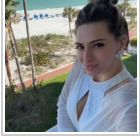
