Marianne (Lapré) Tomasetti, 76, passed away on Wednesday, January 12, 2022. She was the wife of Richard Tomasetti, with whom she celebrated their 48th anniversary the day earlier.

Born in Providence, she was a daughter of the late Charles and Marion (Kelly) Lapré. She held a number of jobs throughout her life, but was exceptionally proud of the 24 years she dedicated to students at a variety of schools in the Johnston Public School system, working as a teacher's aide, primarily for children in the special education system. Late in life, she proved herself an incredibly strong and resilient woman, courageously battling and defeating a very advanced lung cancer.
