Stanley J. Ainley, 92, died peacefully with family by his side on November 18, 2015 at the Davis Health Care Center in Wilmington, NC. Born in Greystone, RI on September 20, 1923, he was the son of the late Alton and Lillian (Wilkinson) Ainley. He was the husband of the late Lois (Angell) Ainley for 72 years. Stanley served in the US Navy for 22 years and was in the submarine service during WWII, serving on the USS Sea Owl and the USS Bang.
